


Establishing a Director ID


A step-by-step guide for domestic directors

Step 1: Set up your myGovID.


- Using a smart device, download the myGovID app from the Apple App Store or Google Play store.
- Enter the required details, including name, date of birth and email address. Use a personal (rather than work or shared) email address.
- A list of options will become available for you to upgrade your identity verification strength from “Basic”. In order to have a Director ID, your account must have at least “Standard” identity verification strength.



- Take a photo of the required documents (shown in the screenshot above) via the app using the “Scan my card” or equivalent feature shown on the screenshots below. Examples of the Driver’s licence and Medicare card screens are found below.



- To create a “Strong” identity verification strength account, take a photo of yourself following the below instructions.




- Once your myGovID is established, it will tell you the strength of your identity.



Step 2: Using your computer, login to the following website using the same email address that you used to create your myGovID profile.

Step 3: Enter the 4-digit code that appears on the web page into your smart device on your myGovID app and click “Accept”.



Step 4: Return to your computer, where you will be redirected to a page titled ‘Proof of record ownership’.

Agree to the terms and conditions and click “Next”.

Apply for a director identification number

Getting a director ID Step 1 of 3

All fields marked with * are mandatory

Application requirements

You can apply for a director identification number if you are:

- > an eligible officer or
- > intend to become an eligible officer within 12 months after applying.

An eligible officer is:

- > an appointed director or alternate director (acting in that capacity), of a company, body corporate that is a registered Australian body or registered foreign company.

The Registrar may make a determination that a particular person or class of persons are not eligible officers.

You should not apply for a director identification number if you already have an active director identification number unless you have been directed to by the Registrar.

To be eligible to be a director of a company, you must:

- > be an individual, (i.e. a natural person)
- > be at least 18 years of age; and
- > not be disqualified from [managing corporations](#), or unless the appointment is made with the permission of ASIC or leave of the Court.

Step 6: Enter your TFN, and other required details, such as:

- previous names you have been known by (if any);
- place of birth;
- residential address;
- postal address; and
- contact details.
